PRODUCTION PLANNING & ESTIMATING

The Cape Chamber will once again be presenting the Production Planning & Estimating Course in 2012.

This course is aimed at candidates who have successfully completed the Estimating for Printers Course. It should be noted – however – that the course has not only been attended by prospective Production Planners and Print Estimator's but has, over the years, also been attended by:

- Company Directors/Owners
- Print Sales Representatives
- Production Planners
- Graphic Artists
- Machine Minders
- Book Binders
- Work Ticket Writers
- DTP Operators

The course is suitable for anyone who wishes to improve his/her knowledge of the Industry. It is not only aimed at those who have industry experience but is there for anyone who is prepared to study and who will attend classes regularly.

It is necessary to hold lecture sessions of three hours on Saturday mornings. Students will be divided into syndicates or work groups and be given projects that will require intensive concentration to affect a solution within the lecture period. The course will conclude with examinations, as is the case with the conventional course. It is imperative that students have adequate knowledge of the printing processes that give rise to one of the entry requirements mentioned.

NB: The Cape Peninsula University of Technology recognises the standard of PIFSA's Production Planning & Estimating Certificate. Successful completion of this course results in a credit being granted towards the National Diploma in Printing Management.
